- copy of the program approval letter or e-mail received from the Registrar–Teacher Certification;
- signed and completed Application for Change in Classification or a signed letter of application;
- money order (*PERSONAL CHEQUES NOT ACCEPTED*) payable to the Minister of Finance, Nova Scotia to cover processing costs (current fee \$35.00); check the teacher certification website at <http://certification.ednet.ns.ca> for fee updates;

AND

- EITHER, an official transcript(s) verifying coursework completed AND the award of the approved degree/diploma/certificate (degree information will not appear on transcript until graduation date for your class);
- OR, official transcript(s) verifying coursework completed AND a letter from the Registrar's Office of the university confirming that you have completed all requirements for the award of the approved degree/diploma/certificate and on what date you will be awarded that approved degree/diploma/certificate.
